His research specializes in the field of second language speech learning, and pronunciation and listening teaching, and his work has been published in several international academic journals, such as Language Learning, Studies in Second Language Acquisition, TESOL Quarterly, Language Teaching Research, International Journal of Applied Linguistics, and Applied Psycholinguistics. In this lecture, Professor Saito will introduce various practical and effective methods to improve the intelligibility of Japanese speakers of English, as well as discuss ways to improve fluency and grammatical accuracy in foreign language classroom settings.
